

Eligibility Requirements for the Boundless Education Program

The following outlines the full eligibility requirements for the Boundless Education Program

Definition of a Student

A student is defined as any individual actively enrolled in one of the following: 1) Accredited public or private primary or secondary school; 2) Accredited higher education institution that grants degrees requiring not less than the equivalent of 2 years of study; 3) Homeschool, as defined by state homeschooling regulations.

Definition of an Educator

An educator is defined as any individual, faculty or staff actively employed by one of the following: 1) Accredited public or private primary or secondary school; 2) Accredited higher education institution that grants degrees requiring not less than the equivalent of 2 years of study; 3) Homeschool, as defined by state homeschooling regulations.

For the purposes of this program, faculty is the academic staff of a university to include adjunct professors, assistant professors, associate professors, tenured (full) professors, lecturers, or researchers.

For the purposes of this program, staff is full- or part-time employees of an academic institution, separate from students and faculty including, but not limited to; department chairs, deans, vice presidents, presidents, and librarians.

Definition of a higher education institution

A higher education institution is defined as any accredited learning establishment including, but not limited to; colleges, universities, vocational and polytechnic schools.

Additional Institutions Covered by this Agreement

Select portions of this program will also extend to National Laboratories and Technical Centers, as well as University Affiliated Research Centers doing work on behalf of federal government agencies. Decisions to extend to additional institutions and organizations will be determined by Boundless on a case-by-case basis.

Qualification Requirements

In order to qualify for the Boundless Education Program, students and educators must register with their institution's email address (.edu or similar) to provide proof of enrollment or employment. The use of an active and valid academic email is required.

Final discretion and determination of eligibility is reserved for Boundless staff on a case-by-case basis. Boundless reserves the right to modify, or terminate parts of this program at any time, and without advanced notice, at the discretion of Boundless and its employees.
